Unless you are using vouchers, we will need all bookings to be secured via a BACS payment transfer between the 1st September & 4th September (please do **not** pay during August).

From September 2022 the cost of each session will be £4.75*

* a sibling attending the same session will receive a discounted rate of £4.25 per session.

Afternoon Session 1: 3.20pm – 4.20pm

Afternoon Session 2: 4.20pm – 5.20pm

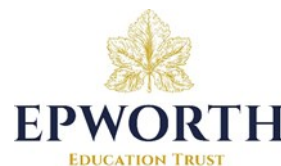
