## Coronavirus Update & School Events

As you will aware, Covid rates in the area are increasing again. We did have a positive case over the holiday which unfortunately led to some members of our school community having to isolate. Thank you for your cooperation with this, I appreciate how difficult it can be to receive an isolate notification, particularly if you had holiday plans. We continue to monitor the rates closely and are awaiting updates regarding the next steps on the roadmap out of lockdown as I'm sure you all are. We will be awaiting these details before releasing full details of events such as sports day and leavers events as we will need to operate within these restrictions. We do intend to go ahead with these in whatever way we can. I wanted to take the opportunity to remind all parents about the procedures to follow relating to a suspected or confirmed Covid case. If you or your child / children have any Coronavirus symptoms, the whole household will need to self-isolate until you receive a negative result from a test. Please do not send your children to school if anyone in your household has any one of the symptoms. Please remember that if you or a family member is symptomatic, a PCR test must be used, not a lateral flow test.

If the test result is positive, the symptomatic person needs to self-isolate for 10 days and all other members of the household will also need to self-isolate for 10 days. **In an update, due to high numbers of infections, close contacts of a confirmed case should also now book a PCR test.** Once you receive a positive test result, please contact school immediately. We will then need to liaise with Public Health and plan next steps with regards to 'track and trace'. If it is necessary to close any class bubbles, we will contact parents / carers by text message initially and then follow up with further information via email.
