This half term our focus school value is Equality. We have been using our Author of the Month book 'The Spots and the Dots' by Helen Baugh to explore and reflect on this.

We are also exploring the creation story from the Bible and considering how Christians believe everyone is made in God's image. 'So God created human

beings, making them to be like himself'. This reference teaches that as all human beings have been created in the image of God, everyone has the same worth and value. No one should be treated in a less favourable way. We will also be exploring equality and prejudice in the words of Luke 6:37, 'Do not judge others and you will not be judged' and Matthew 22:34-40, 'Love your neighbour as yourself'. Finally, we will look at messages of equality in a variety of world religions.
