*Develop 3D art skills:*

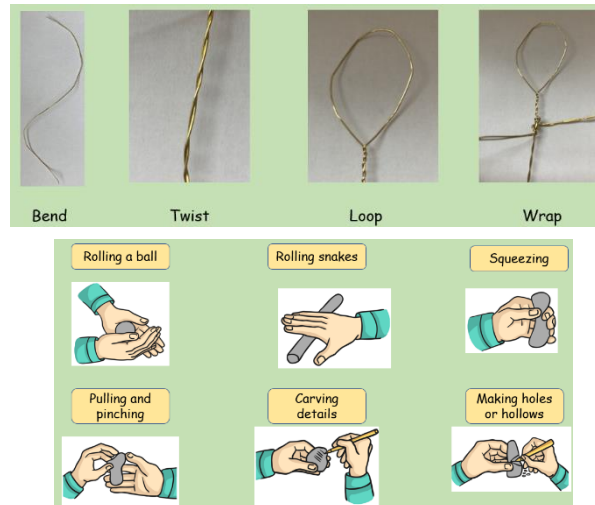
- Know how to join clay pieces together and how to make a clay pot, tile or other sculpture.

<b>Artist</b>	A person who creates art
<b>2D</b>	Something that is flat against a surface
<b>3D</b>	Something that has depth
<b>Texture</b>	How something feels or looks like it feels
<b>Kneading</b>	Preparing clay with your hands to remove air bubbles and make it soft
<b>Mould</b>	Shaping/forming a material
<b>Carve</b>	Using tools to cut into an object
<b>Sculpt</b>	To form, shape and manipulate material
<b>Evaluate</b>	To judge the quality of something
<b>Realistic</b>	Art that is true to life
<b>Abstract</b>	Art that does not show things as true to life
