

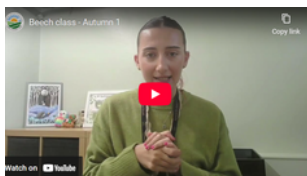


Summerseat Methodist Primary School Newsletter

SUPERSONIC Phonic Friends

We are implementing a whole school daily phonics or spelling session on our timetable where children will be grouped according to their phonic/ spelling level. The sessions will be taught across the school at the same time and reading books aligned with phonic ability as they have always been. In order to support this we will be sending home a phonics/ spelling activity leaflet home with your child every time they move onto a new set of graphemes (letters) or a new spelling rule. There are ideas on the sheets about how you can support your child at home with this and your help with this would be much appreciated. Reading is the best way to support your child's education.
