There have sadly been numerous incidents reported around school this last 3 weeks by many parents and residents.

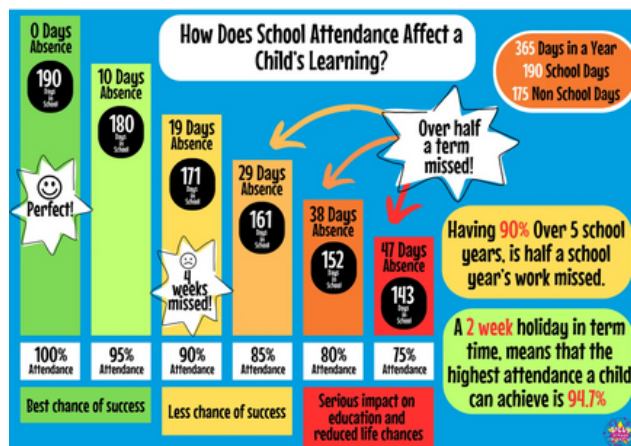
