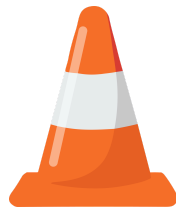
Head of School's Message...

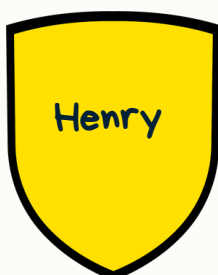
